PLANT LOOK-A-LIKES

Yellow Flag Iris and Cattail (Bullrush)



CATTAIL (BULLRUSH)

NATIVE PLANT

- Can grow to 3 m tall
- Flowers in early March

SHOOTS




No purple at base of shoots

LEAVES



Cattail leaves have a rounded base

Iris leaves have a fan-





CROSS SECTION



Leaves are D-shaped: Flat on one side and rounded on the other

Leaves are flat and have a ridge down the middle



STFM



Stems are round and have a honeycomb-like structure

Stems are almondshaped, often with a purple hue



FLOWER



Flowers are thick. brown, and cigarshaped spikes

Flowers are yellow, with three upright and three drooping sepals/petals



YELLOW FLAG IRIS

INVASIVE PLANT TOXIC

- Can grow to 1.5 m tall
- Flowers in early June
- · Sap can cause skin irritations

Do not consume

Shoots have purple coloring at the base
